Ms Tim Jee is an occupational therapist specializing in assessing and intervention of children with developmental and learning differences. She graduated from Nanyang Polytechnic and the Queen Margaret University, Edinburgh. She is a member of the Singapore Association of Occupational Therapists (SAOT) and is registered with the Singapore Allied Health Professional Council (AHPC). Her clinical experience includes working with children and adults who experience mental health and physical issues. In addition to children with special needs, she has also invested time working with children in mainstream schools. She has participated in school holiday programs to help them bridge learning gaps.
